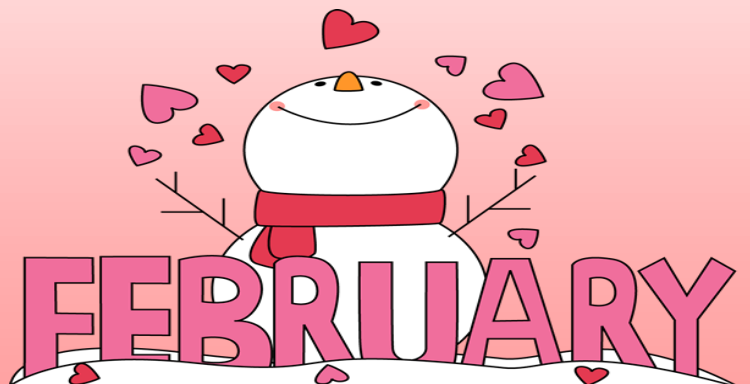

At the February gathering we will have a set of numbered cards, #1-36 for each walk, available for anyone who would like to begin praying for a pilgrim. Closer to the Walk, when the pilgrim roster is confirmed, we will notify each Prayer Partner of the name of his/her pilgrim. Prior to the Walk you will have the opportunity to pray for your pilgrim before you know them by name and then once you have their name, you can personalize your prayers. You can also take the opportunity to write him/her an agape letter to let them know that you had them bathed in prayer before and throughout their Emmaus experience! 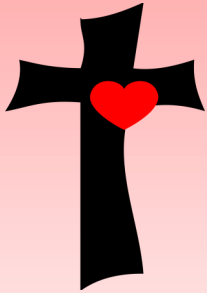
